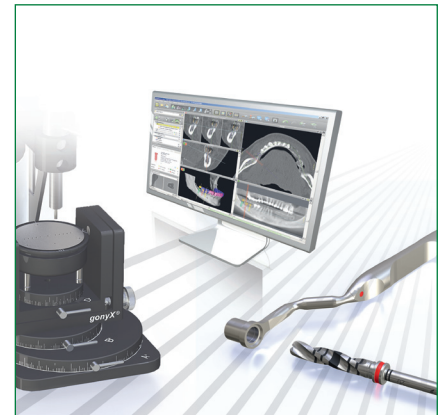


Program description

Digital case planning and guided surgery options are proliferating rapidly and Millennium Research Group recently forecasted that over 10% of implants placed in the US in 2012 would be placed with surgical templates. This course will review the current guided surgery market and discuss what options are available to the clinician today including how these systems differ in their features, benefits and workflows.

Participants will also learn how guided surgery and digital case planning can enhance the relationship between the dentist, their surgical referral and the dental lab that may help provide a more predictable outcome. A review of recent cases completed with guided surgery will also be presented.
